Award Description

This award recognizes a physiotherapist who has made extraordinary, long-term contributions to the profession over the span of their career. Recipients have demonstrated excellence in practice, leadership, advocacy, mentorship, research, or service and have significantly impacted physiotherapy in Alberta and beyond.



Eligibility & Criteria

Nominees must:

- Be physiotherapists with 15+ years of professional experience (retired or currently practicing)
- Demonstrate sustained contributions that have improved physiotherapy practice, policy, education or public health.
- Show leadership, mentorship, and a legacy of advancing the profession.
- Have had a measurable, positive, and lasting impact on physiotherapy in Alberta.

- Nominee name and contact information.
- Summary of career and contributions (750 words).
- Description of long-term impact and legacy (500 words).
- Evidence of leadership, mentorship, or influence (optional attachments).
- Letters of support (recommended but optional).
