



Student / Entry to Practice Leadership Award



Award Description

This award recognizes a student currently enrolled in an accredited physiotherapy program, a new graduate within their first two years of practice, or an internationally educated physiotherapist within 24 months of initial registration who demonstrates exceptional leadership, initiative, and commitment to advancing the physiotherapy profession in Alberta. Recipients show promise as future leaders through engagement in professional activities, advocacy, community involvement, or contributions to the Alberta Association of Physiotherapy (AAP).



Eligibility & Criteria

Nominees must:

- Be a current physiotherapy student **or** within 24 months of initial registration as a physiotherapist.
- Demonstrate emerging leadership qualities.
- Exhibit professionalism, collaboration, and commitment to the values of the profession.
- Show positive impact on peers, the profession, or the community.



Nomination Details

- Nominee name, contact information, and current student/new grad status.
- Educational program and expected/actual graduation date.
- Description of leadership activities or contributions (500 words).
- Example(s) of impact on peers, the profession, or community (300 words).
- Supporting documents (optional): CV, letters of support, project summaries.
